# Regular Meeting of the Lovells Township Board September 8, 2015

**PRESENT**: Ann C. Duby, Cheryl Hopp, Cynthia Infante, Heather Lovell, and Gary A. Neumann.

Supervisor Neumann called the Board Meeting to order at 7:00 PM. Followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

7:01 PM-Neumann recessed the Regular Meeting of the Board to enter into the Public Hearing on the EMS/Fire & Landfill Budgets for FY 2016-17. Neumann reviewed the proposed EMS/Fire Budget and proposed millage rate. Neumann reviewed the proposed Landfill Budget and proposed millage rate.

Neumann moved, Lovell supported a motion to adopt the FY 2016-17 Fire/EMS Budget as previously presented and discussed, with estimate income at \$96,426 and estimated expenses at \$96,426. In a Roll Call Vote: All Ayes. MOTION CARRIED.

Neumann moved, Infante supported a motion to adopt the FY 2016-17 Landfill Fund Budget as previously presented and discussed, with estimate income at \$68,200 and estimated expenses at \$54,646. In a Roll Call Vote: All Ayes. MOTION CARRIED.

Neumann moved, Hopp supported a motion to accept the minutes of the 8/11/15 Regular Meeting of the Board. All Ayes. MOTION CARRIED.

Neumann moved, Hopp supported a motion to approve pre-paid vouchers dated August 11, 2015 through September 8, 2015 as presented: General Fund totaling \$7,337.98; Direct Deposit Checks totaling \$6,056.94; Fire Fund totaling \$5,281.60; Landfill Fund totaling \$33,890.19; and Liquor Fund totaling \$73.50. In a roll call vote: All Ayes. MOTION CARRIED.

Exhibit. Richard Perry, HS Chair, presented their plan and requested Board approval to proceed with negotiations with a proposal forthcoming in approximately 60 days.

Infante moved, Lovell supported a motion to entrust the Historical Society with continuing negotiations for the proposed project in keeping with the basic principles as presented. All Ayes with Neumann abstaining. MOTION CARRIED.
