
Dump Permit Required

NEWSPAPERS:

 Newspapers and inserts, magazines, catalogs, phonebooks, TV Guides,

- Reader's Digest, computer and office Paper, coupons, junk mail, envelopes
- NO CARBON PAPER, PAPER OR PLASTIC BAGS
- PLEASE GIVE SHREDDED PAPER TO ATTENDANT

#1 PLASTIC:

- Containers with a #1 on the container (beverage, water, pop, juice, etc.) and some food containers
- Please rinse and discard caps
- NO OIL OR HAZARDOUS MATERIAL CONTAINERS

MILK JUGS/#2 PLASTIC:

- Containers with a #2 on the container (milk, detergent, bleach jugs, etc.)
- Please rinse and discard caps
- NO OIL OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS
 CONTAINERS

NO CONSTRUCTION OR RUBERIZED STYROFOAM

Please give Styrofoam to attendant

BATTERIES:

- Household and Auto
- Please give to attendant
