Travel Trailer/Recreational Vehicle Permit

Issuance of this permit allows, in all zoning districts, the location and use of one travel trailer or recreational vehicle on an unimproved lot or otherwise vacant property, subject to the conditions noted below.

1. Placement on the property and use of the travel trailer/recreational vehicle shall not exceed ninety (90) days (total) in a calendar year, and the unit must be removed by December 1st to preclude a "snowed/frozen in" situation. This permit may be extended, at no cost, for an additional 90 day period provided (1) the permittee has a permit to build a permanent dwelling unit on his/her property and (2) construction of the permanent dwelling is progressing at an appropriate rate, as determined by the Lovells Township Zoning Administrator.
2. Yard setback requirements for the district where the unit is located must be met.
3. Sanitation facilities must meet the requirements established by the District Health Department.
4. The travel trailer/recreational vehicle must carry current state license plates.
5. This permit must be placed in such a manner that it can be read from the exterior of the travel trailer/recreational vehicle (such as in a window).
6. For your safety, it is *strongly* recommended that you display an address at your roadway/driveway intersection so that emergency responders can locate you. Crawford County Central Dispatch (989-348-4911) will provide you with an official address that can be posted at the roadway/driveway intersection. The instructions and forms that are required to apply for an address are attached for your convenience.
7. You are encouraged to maintain a neat and orderly camp site. To this end a Lovells Township Dump Site permit, at no charge, is available to you along with this permit, should you desire one.
8. In the interest of harmony and a peaceful camping experience for all, you are encouraged to be mindful of noise pollution and, in particular, to be respectful of nearby neighbors.
9. Forest fires are a constant danger here in the north country and fires should only be built in metal fire rings; never on open ground. Also, be mindful of the Michigan DNRs fire danger levels and refrain from building *any* fires during extremely dry or windy conditions.
